

Course & Clinic Hosting

Are you interested in hosting the High Intensity Grinding Course or the Carbide Master-Grinder Clinic?

What are the benefits?

- You will get customers and potential customers into your facility.
- You will have the opportunity to talk to customers and potential customers during group activities.
- You can send two attendees to the course for free.
- You can give attendees a tour of your facilities during the open lunch on Day 2.

What are the requirements?

- You have a conference room that can accommodate 20 people.
- You will supply a projector, a backup projector and a whiteboard.
- You will assist in organizing a group hotel rate, coffee delivery, group dinner, etc.
- You will send an announcement about the course to your customers.

Will I have to pay?

No. Dr. Badger pays for coffee breaks, group meals, etc. However, on Day 2 there is an open two-hour lunch. Attendees are given the option of taking a tour of the host's facilities. Typically, all course attendees choose to go on the tour. If the host company gives a tour, they are asked to supply sandwiches and drinks afterwards.
